I'm Professor at Aix-Marseille Université and Senior Lecturer at the University of Geneva. I teach Arabic, Islamic Studies, the Islamic Intellectual Tradition and Arabic and Jewish philosophy. A specialist of Avicenna, I have published the first Italian translation of Avicenna's *Metaphysics* (2002, 2006) and various essays on Avicenna and other Arabic thinkers, including al-Fārābī and Yahyā ibn 'Adī. I'm the author of the first translation of Yahyā ibn 'Adī's *Treatise on Divine Unity* (2020). Among my books: *Fluxus* (2011), *Avicenna* (2012), *Studying Arabic Philosophy* (2019, edited with J.-B. Brenet). Together with Meryem Sebti, I'm now working on the French translation of Avicenna's *K. al-Nafs* within the project *Tarnslitterae* (ENS, Paris; dir. M. Sebti). Since 2023, I direct a research project ("I.F.I.: "Pour une islamologie d'excellence") on 'L'Un divin et ses multiples: modèles du *tawhid* entre philosophie, shiisme et soufisme".
